Mr./Mrs. \_\_\_ has Parkinson disease for \_\_\_\_\_ years. He/She is well controlled on LIST MEDICATIONS. He/She is not at risk for delirium (due to RBD or cognitive decline). If delirium occurs, please try to minimize analgesia and night time sedation. If necessary use quetiapine 12.5-50 mg qhs.

Do NOT use Risperdal or olanzipine as they will worsen parkinsonism. He also has (include all that apply: orthostatic hypotension, urinary incontinence, severe constipation).

Throughout the hospitalization including the day of surgery, please try and maintain the schedule to ensure that he is mobile and able to rehabilitate.
